Scholarship recipients have demonstrated excellence within the award criteria and must pursue post-secondary education at a college or technical school following high school.

ENDOWMENT/MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IMPORTANT PART OF LQPV DOLLARS FOR SCHOLARS

Endowed scholarships awarded each year include: Preston and Brownie "Ethelyn" Mork Endowed Scholarship—This scholarship was established by the Preston Mork family in memory of Preston and Brownie Mork.

- **Harvest Partners Agriculture Scholarship**—Harvest Partners was American Cyanimid's preferred customer program. Roger Strand, of Milan, is to be credited for the creation of this scholarship. Donations came from American Cyanimid dealers and customers.
- **Carl Thorstenson Academic Excellence Scholarship**—This scholarship will be awarded to a top student in the class each year. This award of at least \$1,500 award is the result of a gift from Mr. Thorstenson's estate.
- **Junyce and Harry Nordby Math Scholarship**—Junyce and Harry were strong supporters of the Dollars for Scholars program in its early years. Harry passed away in 1998 and Junyce in 2000. The scholarship was established in their memory.
- **Chuck Brown Memorial Scholarship**—Former State Representative Chuck Brown was dedicated to his community, family, friends and the rural way of life. There was no stronger voice and supporter of Lac qui Parle Valley schools and the Dollars for Scholars program. A scholarship in his memory has been established following a memorial gift from his family.
- **Will Skreberg Scholarship**—Mr. Skreberg, a Dollars for Scholars contributor through the Phone-A-Thon, died in 2005. He left a gift of over \$100,000 do LqPV Dollars for Scholars. The 2007 Will Skreberg Scholarships will total \$5,000.
- **Wally & Arlys Heinecke Scholarship**—A gift from the estate of Wally & Arlys Heinecke will add a total of \$5,000 to this year's scholarships. Wally died in 2003 and Arlys in 2005.
- **Bruce Moen Memorial Scholarship**—Bruce, Moen, a graduate of Milan High School, died as a result of a traffic accident on February 29, 2008. His family designated LqPV Dollars for Scholars as a preferred memorial for Bruce. An agriculture scholarship will be given in his memory.

Non-perpetual scholarships include:

- **James Hoover Memorial Scholarship**—A scholarship in memory of James Hoover, who passed away on June 23, 2001 was established in 2002. A scholarship is awarded annually to a student who is interested in pursuing a career in Industrial Arts/Technology. Mr. Hoover spent most of his teaching career in Madison where he taught Industrial Arts for 33 years.
- **Olga B. Hart Foundation Scholarship**—The annual distribution from the Olga B. hart Foundation funds scholarships in Education and Human Services, and also supplements several other scholarships.
- **Dan Besonen Memorial Scholarship**—Mr. Besonen was a teacher and coach at LqPV and Madison High School and an avid golfer. Funds for the scholarship are raised via an annual golf tournament.

LqPV National Honor Society Raises Funds through annual Dollars for Scholars Phone-A-Thon



The Lac qui Parle Chapter of the National Honor Society held its 11th annual Dollars for Scholars Phone-A-Thon on January 17 and 20, 2010. All funds raised go to the Dollars for Scholarship program. 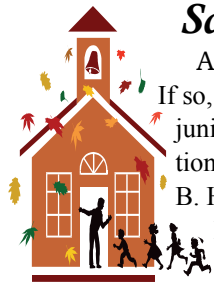

Special points of interest:

- Dollars for Scholars has approximately 50 sponsors who sponsor scholarships through annual gifts or have established scholarships as memorials to family members.
- Awarded 71 scholarships worth \$75,100 in 2009.
- In 2010, scholarships will range from \$600 to \$2,000. A student can receive only one scholarship, thereby giving more students opportunities for financial help.
- Scholarships are currently awarded in 30 areas, giving every student a chance to qualify.
- 1090 Scholarships totaling \$678,000 have been awarded since 1991.
